

Colors

Goal-To practice identifying the colors red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown, black and white.



HOW TO PLAY I “SPY”

- The game can be played both indoors or outdoors.
- The person selecting the object is called 'the Spy'.
- Look around the area you are in and focus on an object that is within view of the other players.
- Once an object has been selected, the 'Spy' says, "I spy with my little eyes..."
- Clues may be given to assist the early learners on their quest
- The player who guesses correctly is the next one to give clues as the Spy for a different object.



To play 'I Spy' with colours, pick up a card and hold it up close to the early learner. Say, I Spy with my little eyes something red or any of the colours that are on the card.

NOTE: If the early learner isn't familiar with the colours you may want to describe other things about the object you are looking at.

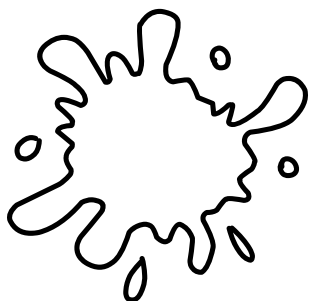

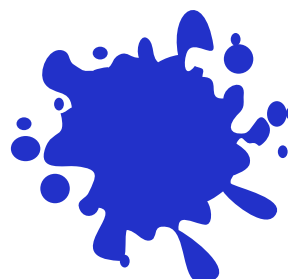
