Greetings and Introductions

The Early Childhood Educator can teach the 'Who Are You' song to assist with the Early Learner's comprehension of the song. As the Early Learners listen to the song, the Early Childhood Educator can perform an action, both demonstrating and saying the word tânisi or any of the other words in the song. The Early Childhood Educator will call on the Early Learners to repeat the action and articulate the word. The process should be repeated several times to assuage any discomfort of making a mistake.
